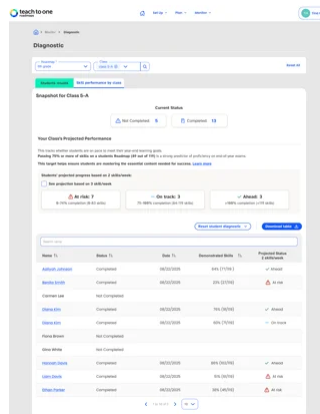
🌟 Onboarding Course Competition 🌟
